- Abstracts must be submitted online only through the website, abstracts submitted via email/fax or any other means will not be accepted.
- All abstracts must be submitted in English language only.
- Registration is mandatory for any kind of participation during the conference.
- Abstracts of both Oral Papers & Posters must be restricted upto 350 words.
- The title of the abstract must be concise, avoid using abbreviations.
- Oral Papers/Posters should have the following headings: Aim/purpose, methods, results and conclusions. For Case report: Introduction, Case description, Conclusion.
- Do not include graphs/tables/images/references in the abstract. Do not mention the name of the institute or any author names in the abstract body.
- The abstract submission is open till 15<sup>th</sup> January 2026 midnight (IST). Late submissions will NOT be accepted.
- Categories: Clinical (original research), Laboratory (original research), Case report, Others.
- The submitted abstracts will be reviewed by the scientific committee. The review process is confidential, and the committee's decision is final.
